

## Rice Boy

From Canadian farmland to modern India, two worlds collide. The boundaries of nation, home, and family become memory and imagination for a twelve-year old boy. Like intricate rice patterns, stories and images flood Tommy's mind: late afternoon hockey games on frozen ponds; billowing red and gold saris; Mennonites and German farmers; coolies at railway stations; Quebec threatens to leave Canada; picking fresh blueberries; a disabled girl swirling rice powder on a cement floor; and waiting for a husband who does not come. A lyrical and beautiful play by emerging East Indian playwright Sunil Kuruvilla, RICE BOY takes us into the far reaches of the rich and imaginative mind of a boy coming of age.
